Refreshing

Restoring

- Finding out and realizing God's gifts and talents.

Equipping

Learning how to take land as we receive vision and develop God's gifts and talents by:

- Having opportunity to hone, discover and develop gifts in a safe environment.
- Minister and release God's blessing through the gifts.

Releasing

Learning how to take land through the grasping of a sense of God's direction and destiny by:

- Understanding how to position ourselves to extend God's kingdom.
- Learning how to appropriate a Christian worldview in life.
- Honoring and furthering the apostolic model of church in society.

2. Application of teaching in practical service

- Involvement in the day to day running of a church (worship, sound technology, prayer, operational aspects, youth ministry) etc.
- Coexisting with others to establish a Godly home environment (budgeting, house maintenance, cooking, conflict management).
- Involvement in the setting up and running of a 'Prayer room / furnace'.
- Reaching out to widows, orphans and the poor in and around Durbanville.
- Preparing for, and completing a cross-cultural, international outreach to Botswana, and Kenya (optional).
